

ESL School

Cornerstone designed and provides different consecutive levels' of online English courses from Kindergarten to high school. Students can learn native English with American teachers and books at any place and time.

The Cornerstone ESL School is made up of Pre-k to Grade 1, Primary School, and High School. Based on different learning demands in different levels, Cornerstone offers different levels' of English learning courses. Part V- English Academy

Academic English School

EAP (English for Academic Purposes) was designed for students who plan to study in an American high school or university but never systematically learned in English listening, speaking, reading and writing and have never taken similar Cornerstone ESL School courses. In the EAP program, Cornerstone is not taking the place of American schools in teaching different subjects but paying more attention to expanding the students' academic terminologies and teach them how to understand the questions of different subjects. EAP is divided into three levels – Middle School Academic English, High Academic English, University Academic English.

Culture Exchange Camps

Students develop cultural literacy as well as enhanced cognitive skills much more quickly in language immersion study abroad program rather than tradition language school class.

Cornerstone Recruiting Procedures

STEP 1: Evaluation

- Online Interview with Cornerstone advisors
- Written test with Cornerstone Shanghai office teachers
- Online surveys for parents to know more about family needs
- Create an evaluation report upon the student readiness to study abroad upon his/her English Competence, Mind Readiness and Behavior Readiness and Academic Strength
- Recommendations of schools for those who are ready
- Customized English Training Plan
- This report will be bilingual and sent to both parents and school

STEP 2: School Review / Interview

- School will review or set up interview with the students
- School will make admission decisions
- School will provide acceptance letter
- Student sign the enrollment plan and pay deposit
- School will issue the I-20

STEP 3: Student Registration

- Cornerstone provide student visa application support and interview training
- Cornerstone signs the service provided contract guardianship agreement with student and parents
- Cornerstone help students with housing selection: Cornerstone dorm or CSHomestay

STEP 4: Student Orientation

- Cornerstone mails the family welcome package
- Cornerstone host NEW student and parent online orientation during the summer
- Cornerstone dorm teacher/coordinator pick up students at airport
- Cornerstone host week long dorm/homestay orientations with student rules and culture trainings based on student manual
- Cornerstone staffs help student to settle down (shopping, bank, cellphone, books, health forms, insurance, etc.)
